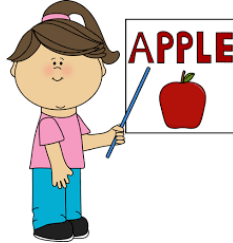


Orton-Gillingham and Phonological Awareness Groups

Children's Speech and Language Services, Inc. in Falls Church, VA is pleased to offer Orton-Gillingham and Phonological Awareness groups this fall.

Orton-Gillingham is a research based systematic approach used to explicitly teach fundamental skills related to decoding (reading) and encoding (spelling). It incorporates multi-sensory techniques including: auditory, visual and kinesthetic modalities to teach the structure of the English language.

Phonological Awareness is the greatest predictor of literacy success. It consists of: listening skills, rhyming, segmenting (hearing individual sounds in words), blending (combining sounds to make words) and phonemic awareness (understanding of sound and letter correspondence).

Fall sessions will be held on Thursday afternoons September through December 2017

- Fall dates: Mid-September- Mid December 2017
- Specific dates and times for your child's group will be determined upon registration
- Classes will be held for 60-minutes each week
- \$100 per 60-minute session (e.g. \$1000 for 10-week fall session)
- Families are required to pre-register for fall groups
- Orton-Gillingham groups will not be billed to insurance
